



## An Update in regards to the Proposed Amendment to Silverdale School Zone

5<sup>th</sup> April 2016

Dear Parents/Caregivers,

The Silverdale School Board of Trustees received a letter on the 4<sup>th</sup> April 2016 from Janet Schofield – Planning Manager, Schooling Networks, Ministry of Education informing us that the Ministry of Education had approved our amendment to our zone.

The Board would like to inform the Silverdale School Community that the Board resolved to adopt the amended zone on Monday 4<sup>th</sup> April 2016.

The Ministry has included a 'grandparenting clause' in our enrolment scheme, which means that siblings of current students who live within the identified streets (schedule A) will be able to attend Silverdale School as in zone students as long as they reside at their current address.

The new zone will come into effect from the beginning of Term 2 2016.

The School buses will still run as normal.

# Silverdale School ENROLMENT SCHEME

## Home zone

All students who live within the home zone described below (and shown on the attached map) shall be entitled to enrol at the school.

*Starting where State Highway 1 crosses Orewa River, follow the river east and south to Orewa Bridge. Travel south west along the centre of Hibiscus Coast Highway (66-212 even numbers only included) to Millwater Parkway. Continue south west along both sides of Hibiscus Coast Highway (54, 57 and below included). Travel south west along Tavern Road, south east along Foundry Road (entire road included) and south along Ingot Place, west along Furnace Place and Forge Road to East Coast Road (excluded). Travel north to Hibiscus Coast Highway, west to State Highway 1 (Painton Road, Small Road included) and travel north, back to the starting point.*

All residential addresses on included sides of boundary roads and all no exit roads off included sides of boundary roads are included in the zone unless otherwise stated.

Proof of residence within the home zone will be required.

Each year, applications for enrolment for the following year from in-zone students will be sought by a specific date which will be published in a daily or community newspaper circulated in the area served by the school. This will enable the board to assess the number of places which can be made available to students who live outside the home zone.

In addition, the properties described in the attached Schedule marked 'A' shall be deemed to form part of the home zone, provided a child residing at that address has a sibling who attended the school in 2016, and a sibling currently attends the school. When the family living at the address in 2016 ceases residing at the address, the property shall cease to be part of the home zone.

## Out of zone enrolments

Each year the board will determine the number of places which are likely to be available in the following year for the enrolment of students who live outside the home zone. The board will publish this information by notice in a daily or community newspaper circulated in the area served by the school.

The notice will indicate how applications are to be made and will specify a date by which all applications must be received.

Applications for enrolment will be processed in the following order of priority:

- First priority: This priority category is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a special programme approved by the Secretary.
- Second priority: must be given to applicants who are siblings of current students.
- Third priority: must be given to applicants who are siblings of former students.
- Fourth priority: must be given to any applicant who is a child of a former student of the school.
- Fifth priority: must be given to any applicant who is either a child of an employee of the board of the school or a child of a member of the board of the school.
- Sixth priority: must be given to all other applicants.

If there are more applicants in the second, third, fourth, or fifth priority groups than there are places available, selection within the priority group will be by a ballot conducted in accordance with instructions


issued by the Secretary for Education under Section 11G(1) of the Education Act 1989. Parents will be informed of the date of any ballot by notice in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school.

Applicants seeking second or third priority status may be required to give proof of a sibling relationship.
