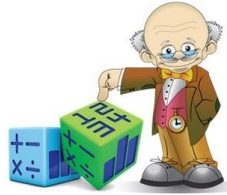
Your school contribution goes towards the following:- material resources for students and their programmes; computer upgrades; internet services; technological development; additional staffing and support services.

Maths-Whizz Tutoring Plus is an online personalised maths programme that we have introduced at Silverdale Primary and it caters for each child's needs. This is an online service and can be used at any time, at home as well as in school, to support your child's development in maths. As a parent you will be able to see your child's lesson history, usage and progression in detailed live reports, which your child's teacher can share with you.

Reading Eggs

Year 0, 1, 5, 6 optional

Reading Eggs was created by teachers to help children become fluent and proficient readers. This online reading programme uses books, games and activities to extend readers from Year 1-8. Reading Eggs has a diagnostic placement test that determines the starting point for each individual and develops their reading skills and knowledge at their own pace. Kindo – Our online school shop

Kindo is designed to make it easy for you to manage school payments and complete permission forms through a simple website.

Kindo links our student records, so student details will be updated automatically. You will not need to enter these when making payments or completing forms.

- **For new Users**

If you do not have an account with Kindo/EZlunch, please follow the steps below to get started – it's super-fast! Please note: you can only sign up to Kindo once your child has started at Silverdale School.

1. Go to www.silverdaleprimary.school.nz
2. Click the Kindo (new registration users) tab
3. Enter in the **same email address** the school has on file for you. Click 'continue'.
4. Go to your email and click the link sent to you.
5. Enter in a password, 'tick' to accept the terms, and click 'continue'.

- **For Existing EZlunch Users**

Kindo is the same system as EZlunch - if you already have an account with EZlunch please follow these steps to get started.

NOTE: your login email address must match that held by the school. If not, change it on the My Details page or update the school

1. Go to www.ezlunch.co.nz
2. Log in and click Fees and Donations and "link these students"
3. Match your children between Kindo and our school student system (e.g. Zoe=Zoe).

Your family account is now set up and you can start shopping! To login next time, click the Kindo Shop on the school website and enter your email address and password.
