


How can you help your child with their learning?

Why have we moved to using SchoolTalk?

- 1. SchoolTalk enables agency for our learners. This means enabling students to own their learning, by helping them be aware of what they can do and what their next learning steps are.
- SchoolTalk provides real time reporting on progress and achievement for parents, students and teachers.
- 3. SchoolTalk creates a learning partnership with whānau, providing resources and personalised support.
- 4. For teachers, SchoolTalk has enabled them to think differently about how they group and design learning to meet all learners needs.



This gives you access to your child's calendar, progressions and reports by using the task bar down the left side. To navigate back to your child's home page just click on their name in the top left hand corner.




Calendar

You can view your child's planned activities for the day and week.



Progressions

This shows what your child has achieved and what their next learning steps are.




Keep clicking on an area to break it down further and to get to the learning steps.



Progressions

This shows what your child has achieved and what their next learning steps are.



 Progressions may be marked as 100% achieved or teachers may mark them as partially achieved if children are starting to show that they are developing an understanding.

- Green Highlighting Your child has achieved the learning intention. Light green has been backfilled - this means that they had already achieved it once we started using SchoolTalk.
- Yellow Highlighting This is a current next learning step for your child.
- Blue Highlighting Your child has submitted evidence of achieving the learning intention and is waiting for the teacher to assess whether it has been achieved for it to be marked green.

Evidence

Teachers and children can add evidence to show their understanding of a progression or a group of progressions.

Evidence may be:

- Comments
- Photos
- Samples of work
- Google Documents
- Videos
- Audio recording

My Learning Journey:

After feedback from students, whanau and staff we have developed an area on SchoolTalk where teachers and students can upload photos, comments or pieces of work for other areas of the curriculum outside of Reading, Writing and Maths. This also includes showing our KERI values, Inquiry Learning, and Learning Through Play for our Year 0 - 2 students. This new area is not about marking off progressions and highlighting next steps but is instead about acknowledging and celebrating the other learning that your child participates in at school. For this area the indicator bar is not indicating a level of progress but rather it is used to indicate time across the school year. Therefore every child will be marked off as 25% for each term of the year.



As a parent, what can I expect to see?

Yr 0 - 2

SchoolTalk is Teacher Led

- Evidence is uploaded by teacher on a regular basis - photos, teacher comments, some videos
- Design for Learning page is shown on the TV screen at school for learners to engage and contribute during a lesson
- Parents can access SchoolTalk in order to support at home
- Learners know that they each have a SchoolTalk account
- Learners know that yellow means 'working towards' and green means 'achieved'.



Teacher is a Guide / Learners begin to Interact with SchoolTalk

- Evidence is uploaded by teacher photos, teacher comments, some videos, Google Docs
- Evidence is sometimes uploaded by the learner with teacher support - google docs, screenshots or photos from their chromebook
- Learners know that they each have a SchoolTalk account and will learn to independently login on their chromebook
- Calendar and Design for Learning page -Learners can access this via their calendar to engage and contribute during a lesson
- Learners know that yellow means 'working towards' and green means 'achieved'
- Learners understand the progressions tagged in the Design for Learning page is their current focus
- Parents can access SchoolTalk to support learning at home



Teacher is becoming a Facilitator / learners being to take ownership of their Learning through SchoolTalk

- Evidence is uploaded by *teacher* photos, teacher comments, some videos, Google Docs
- Evidence is uploaded by the *learner* A range of examples, such as photos, Google Docs/Slides, screenshots or videos from their Chromebook, and other digital tools
- Learners can access the Calendar and Design for Learning page to engage and contribute during a lesson, access their learning, know when to attend workshops with the teacher and to upload evidence.
- Learners are beginning to navigate their progressions to identify their next steps independently. They know that yellow means 'working towards' and green means 'achieved' and blue means that they have added evidence for their teacher to look at.
- Parents can access SchoolTalk to support learning at home.
