## **Sandy Evans Manaakitanga Memorial Award**

Sandy Evans, was teacher aid at Silverdale School for 16 years. She died suddenly in a tragic accident in January 2012. Sandy had an enormous empathy for all students and particularly those she worked with.

Silverdale School Board created a Manaakitanga Memorial for Sandy as they felt she embodied the principles of manaakitanga – extending the hand of friendship, finding positives in all activities, exemplifying tolerance, kindness and empathy to others.

This memorial will be awarded at the end of each term at the final assembly of the term to the student that staff feel is the most worthy recipient from the designated team.

### **Guidelines for awarding the Manaakitanga Memorial**

- Consistent application of being kind to others.
- Going the extra mile without seeking recognition.
- Positive mind set to self and others.
- Ongoing evidence of respect, tolerance and empathy for others.
- Consistently showing our KERI Values of Kindness/Atawhai, Excellence/Hiranga, Respect/Whakaute, Integrity/Ngākau pono

Manaakitanga is the demonstration of showing respect, generosity and care for others. The Manaakitanga award was created by the board of trustees as a memorial for Sandy Evans, a teacher aide at Silverdale School who tragically passed away after an accident in 2012.

Sandy embodied all of the principles of Manaakitanga and this memorial is awarded at the end of each term to the student the staff feel is the most worthy recipient.

This term the recipient of the Manaakitanga memorial has been selected out of Tūi. We have so many students at Silverdale School who consistently show our KERI values that it is always a very tough decision for teachers. This year, there is one student in Tūi who has stood out in particular.

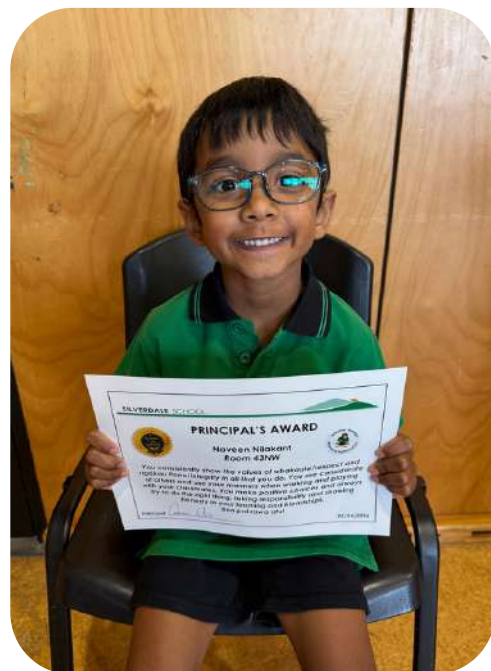
Ititi kārearea teitei kāhikatea ka taea – even the smallest kārearea can reach the top of the tallest kāhikatea. This whakatauki speaks volumes of who you are and what you do for others around you. You ensure that others are able to reach the highest peaks and will support them until they get there.

Quite often it's the big things people notice, the big moments where people acknowledge your achievements. But for you it is those and the small things that you do. It is the offer to play for another team at zone days because they don't have enough players. The willingness to be friends with everyone and show everyone the same kindness. It's standing next to someone who isn't as confident as you and repeating the lines for mihi or a waiata to them. It's allowing those who want to step up to lead and supporting them to do so. These moments are just some of the ones that highlight the whakatauki – you are the reason so many of our iti kārearea are able to fly and reach the highest peaks. You don't ask for thanks – you do it because it is the right thing, you embody manaakitanga. It is with pleasure that we present the award to **Zylah Menehira, Te Rito**.

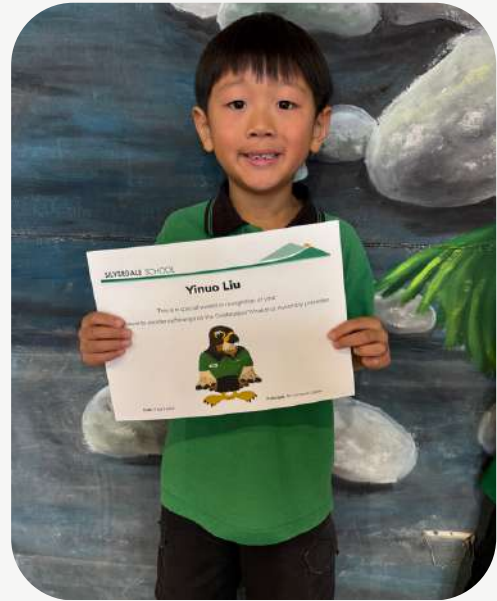
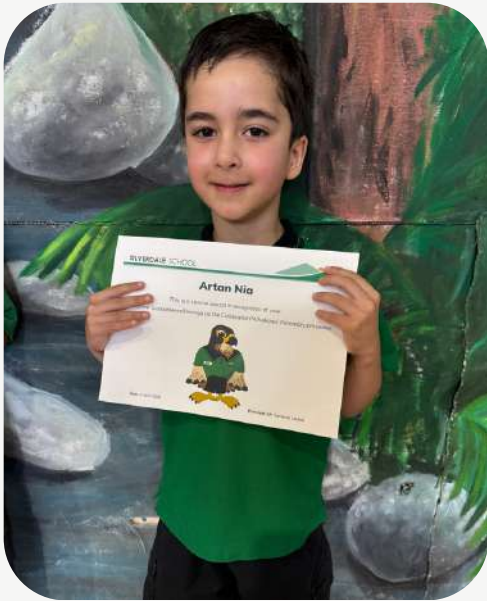

## KERI

KERI is our school mascot who is the guardian of our school. KERI is a karearea and the karearea was chosen because it was our Year 7/8 intermediate team name. Also it is a strong and resilient bird whose prowess is clearly recognised.

Like the karearea, we want our learners to take their learning to new heights. We want them to take risks in their learning and constantly push their boundaries exploring their learning world. We want them to try new challenges and share their growing learning power.

### **Our Team Names Meaning**

The choice of Te Ōhanga (The Nest), Kiwi, Pūkeko, Tūi as our team name fits with our school motto - Learn to Journey - Journey to Learn, Ako ki te Haere - Haere ki te Ako, from our fledgling learners through to our learners who push the boundaries of their learning.

### **Team Te Ōhanga**

A nest provides those that live in it all that they require to survive; food, warmth and shelter. It is a place to be nurtured and loved.

Our nest for the Year 0 and 1's is the starting place for all our learners to begin their learning journey. Everyone starts in the nest needing similar requirements to help them grow and become independent. The Nest nurtures our students and makes them have a love for coming to school, a love for learning, and realise that school is a place to have fun.

### **Team Kiwi**

The kiwi is well grounded searching through the undergrowth for their food, ideally adapted to suit their environment. While they do not use their wings they are still there ready to use should the need arise.

Our young learners are like this, fossicking amongst all that is to be learned, absorbed and adapted to suit the environment and each individual.

### **Team Pūkeko**

The pūkeko is a bird that takes ownership of its world, engaging in short bursts of flight. The pūkeko is eternally inquisitive, wanting to know everything that goes on about it.

Our Year 3 and 4 learners are like this - taking those bursts into learning, retracing their steps, seeking clarity and beginning to really push those boundaries of learning.

### **Team Tūi**

The tūi is a striking bird who is no longer a ground dweller but seeks to explore the tree tops. The tūi is one of the early birds to announce its presence and sing with great skill and delight.

Our young people in Team Tūi are like these birds. They are flexing their learning muscles, enjoying life and take their learning into the wider world. They embrace life and learning.

## Protecting Our School Environment

We love seeing so many of our tamariki using active transport to get to and from Silverdale School. It is wonderful to see so many bikes, e-bikes, and scooters parked up each morning! However, to ensure the safety of everyone on-site and to protect our school facilities, we have a few important reminders regarding "wheels" on school grounds.

We have recently noticed an increase in people riding across our court areas, particularly after school hours. Unfortunately, this is causing significant wear and tear and damage to the surface.

To keep our facilities in top shape please note the following:

- **Walk Your Wheels: Once you enter the school gates, all bikes, e-bikes, e-scooters and scooters must be walked. This applies to students, parents, and visitors at all times of the day.**
- **Courts are Off-Limits: The court areas are now strictly no-riding zones. Please do not ride any form of transport (all bikes, e-bikes, e-scooters and scooters) across the courts, even during the weekends or after school.**
- **Safety First: Walking your bikes, e-bikes, e-scooters and scooters through congested areas during drop-off and pick-up helps keep our youngest learners and their whānau safe from accidental bumps.**

We take great pride in our school environment, and we appreciate your support in looking after our shared spaces so they remain safe and functional for all our students and community.


