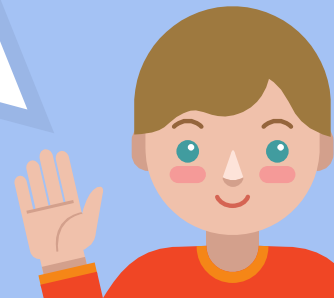
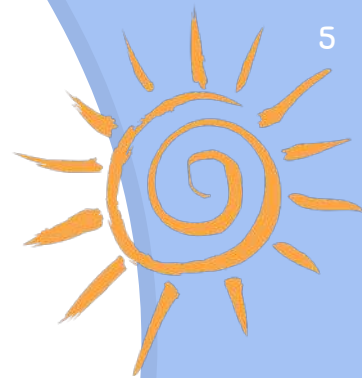

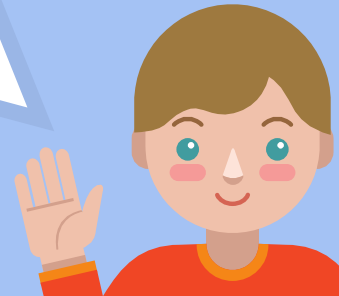

Caller chants: **“Tēnei mea te homai”**

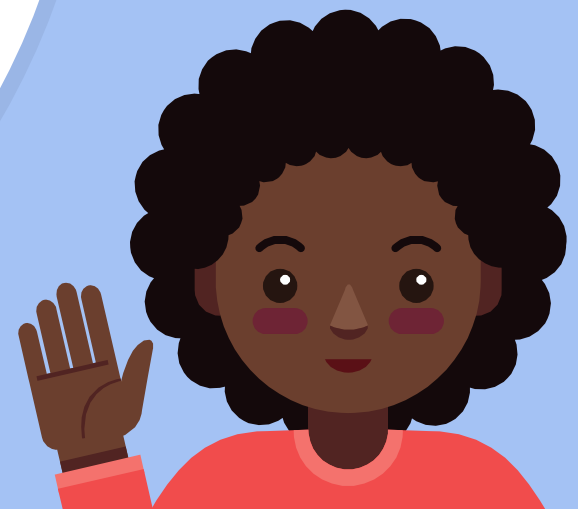
Teh-neigh meh-a teh hore-my

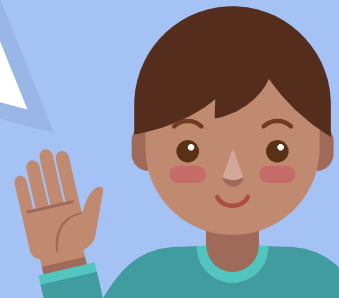
He kemu/A Game
