- Collaborate on ways to support your child's learning.

Each Parent-Teacher Interview session lasts for 15 minutes.

- Thursday 23 July 12.30pm to 6.15pm. School will close early at 12:00pm on Thursday 23 July so interviews can begin. Please arrange to collect your child at midday on this day.

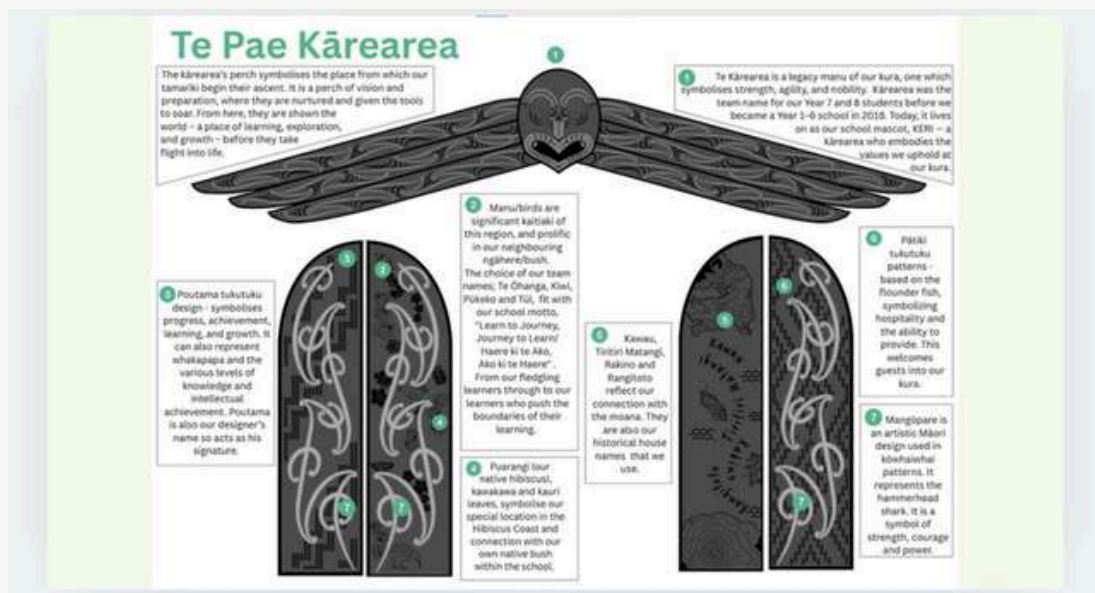


Waha Ātea - Te Pae Kārearea

Last year we unveiled our magnificent Waha Ātea - Te Pae Kārearea. This entranceway is a timeless symbol of our school's connection to local history, identity, and te ao Māori. The opening was held during Matariki, 2025. It was a poignant occasion for storytelling, honouring our past, celebrating our present, and envisioning our future, firmly establishing the Waha Ātea as a sacred taonga for our entire community. Te Pae Kārearea, marked a pivotal milestone in Silverdale School's journey of "Learn to Journey, Journey to Learn." This project was "written by many hands over many years," blossomed from a shared vision and a growing awareness of the vital importance of place, language, and identity in our kura. Recognising our kura's visual story needed richer reflection, we successfully secured Creatives in Schools funding. This enabled a powerful collaboration with a talented artist and kapa haka kaiako Lee-Anne Wade, a valued member of our local marae, and the skilled kai whakairo (carver) Poutama Heteraka, who holds deep mana whenua connections to this area.

Staff worked closely with our creative team and ākonga, collectively exploring the fundamental questions of "Who are we? Where have we come from? What do we carry into the future?". Whaea Lee-Anne's profound knowledge of tikanga and kaupapa Māori, coupled with her strong relationships, proved instrumental in gathering our community's stories and walking the whenua. Poutama then meticulously brought these narratives to life through his design, firmly grounding the Waha Ātea in Silverdale's unique identity.

So the next time you come into school take the time and study Te Pae Kārearea using the information below to help you get a better understanding of what Te Pae Kārearea stands for.



Matariki Celebrations and Hāngī

On Paraire 3 Hūrae / Friday, 3 July our kura will be holding our annual Matariki celebrations. This year, we are incredibly excited to introduce something brand new to our school, a hāngī. We have arranged for a group called 'Hākari Cooker' to come to our school and prepare a feast/hākari with our tamariki.

To round out our Matariki celebrations, the hāngī will be served on Paraire 3 Hūrae / Friday, 3 July at 1:00pm. This is a beautiful opportunity for our ākonga/students to prepare and share in some kai together.

Kindo - Registering and paying for the Hāngī: Please go onto Kindo, to sign up and pay \$8 for the event by Thursday 25 June (Payment and registration cutoff).

The Details:

- The Cost: The cost of the hāngī will be \$8 per head.
- Whānau Vegetable Contribution: To help make this community meal possible, each participating ākonga/student will need to bring either 1 carrot, 1 potato or 1 kūmara to school the day before for prep. Silverdale School will provide the chicken drumstick.
- The Menu: We will be enjoying a contemporary style hāngī cooked in specialised hāngī kai cookers. Each individual portion will be served in plastic containers and includes 1 chicken drumstick, 1 piece of kūmara, 1 piece of potato and 1 piece of carrot.
- Whānau Support Needed: A community event like this takes a village. We would love some whānau support to help us prepare the contributed vegetables on Thursday 2 July (during the last school block at 2:10pm) and to help serve the kai at 1:00pm on Friday 3 July.

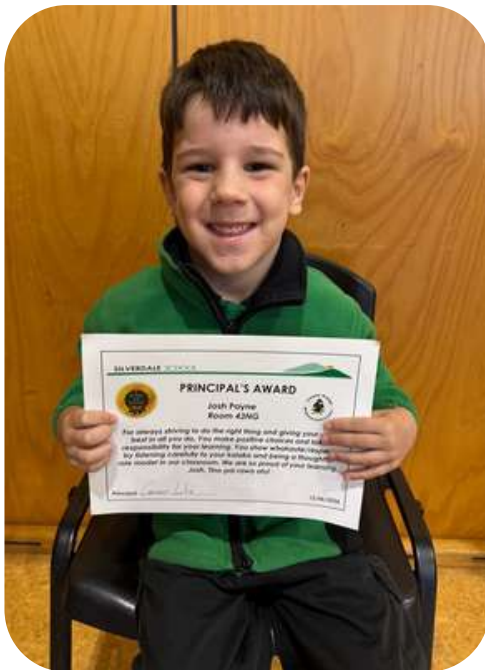
