How the Out of Zone Process Works

Space Assessment

Each year Silverdale School Board reviews school roll projections. If there is capacity to accept out of zone students, the school publicly announces year levels (e.g., New Entrants only) open for application.

Application Submission

Parents submit an official Out-of-Zone Enrolment Application form directly to the school office or via email (enrolments@silverdaleprimary.school.nz) before the advertised deadline.

Priority Order

If the number of out-of-zone applications exceeds the number of places available, New Zealand law requires applications to be processed in the following strict order of priority:

- 1.First Priority: Acceptance into a special programme approved by the Secretary for Education (not applicable to Silverdale School).
- 2.Second Priority: Siblings of current students.
- 3.Third Priority: Siblings of former students.
- 4.Fourth Priority: Children of former students.
- 5.Fifth Priority: Children of Board employees or Board members.
- 6.Sixth Priority: All other child applicants.

The Ballot

If there are more applicants in a priority category than available spaces, a ballot (random draw) is supervised by an independent authority (or police officer/Justice of the Peace) to fill the remaining places. Unsuccessful applicants are placed on a waiting list in the order drawn.

Out-of-zone enrolments are subject to available spaces and processed strictly in accordance with Ministry of Education priority guidelines.

2027 Enrolments

Do you have a child who is turning 5 in 2027? Or do you know of a family who has a child about to turn 5? If so, we would like to have all enrolment forms for any children turning 5 in 2027 into the school office as soon as possible. This information allows us to plan ahead and ensure that we have classrooms ready and class teachers appointed for our new entrant classes. 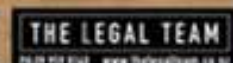
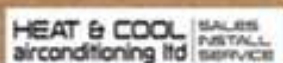
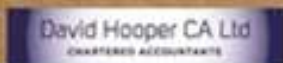

WHAT IS PLASMA?

Plasma is the gold-coloured liquid component of blood that carries blood cells, water, proteins and clotting factors around your body.

WHAT IS IT USED FOR?

Plasma collected in NZ can be used to create up to 11 lifesaving blood products. They help to treat burn victims, kidney patients, chemotherapy patients, people who have lost a lot of blood or have had major surgery, and especially, boost the immune system of people who cannot make antibodies.

CAN I GIVE PLASMA?

You can as long as you:

- Are 16-70 years old
- Weigh a minimum of 50kg and are at least 150cm tall
- Meet the eligibility criteria in our donor questionnaire.



HOW IS GIVING PLASMA DIFFERENT TO GIVING BLOOD?

Donating plasma takes a little longer. With plasma, you're on the donation bed for about 60 minutes compared to 5-10 minutes for whole blood. In all, the whole process with plasma takes about 90 minutes. However, you're able to give plasma more often than blood. You can donate every 2 to 3 weeks, rather than every 3 months. This is because the apheresis machine separates your plasma from the whole blood, keeping only the plasma and returning the red cells (with all the iron) back into your body.

WHAT ELSE DO I NEED TO KNOW?

Before donating, you'll need to have something to eat and drink. It also helps to bring along a book or magazine, as plasma donations do take a bit more time. When you're done, you might not feel as tired as you would after a regular whole blood donation. That's because your red cells are returned to you after being separated from the plasma.
