This year's theme is Ake, Ake, Ake – A Forever Language, with our focus on Te Reo Towns, bringing te reo Māori off the page and into our everyday homes, kura, streets, and communities.

We have a fun-filled week planned for our ākonga, with lots of activities, challenges and opportunities to learn and use te reo Māori together. One challenge will be learning the waiata **'Open Road'** and having a go at saying the different place names featured in the song. Feel free to listen and sing along with your child at home!

We'd also love for our whānau to join in the fun! Check out the Whānau Challenge activities down the side of this newsletter and have a go at completing them together. Sending photo proof of your completed activities to your kaiako earns your whānau an entry into our \$20 Prezzy Card draw – With six cards up for grabs!
